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



# Compliance Impact of COVID-19

Reporting of Claims

- Reporting WC FROI/SROI All States now accepting/requiring use of new codes:
  - → Nature of Injury Code = 83 (COVID-19)
  - → Cause Code = 83 (PANDEMIC)

- Reporting Unit Statistical Reporting – Catastrophe Code = 12
- CA WCIRB
  - → Indemnity Data Call no impacts
  - Proposals to Insurance
     Commissioner re: Claims Reporting and Experience Rating.

## Compliance Impact of COVID-19

Reporting of Claims — OSHA



The agency has suspended requirements related to COVID-19 for employers outside of the healthcare industry unless there is "objective evidence" that the case is work-related and the evidence was "reasonably available" to the employer.



If employer can confirm case of COVID-19 resulted from exposure at work as defined in 29 CFR 1904.5. One or more of the following general recording criteria outlined in 29 CFR 1904.7 must be met.



Illness is to be tracked on OSHA 300 form as Respiratory Illness.
